Details

- The cost is £10.00 per person for a day of activities (food not included so Cubs will need to bring a packed lunch).
- Each Cub Scout will get to participate in four different activities during the day. The activities they get will be a bit of a lucky dip but we will ensure that they are four varied activities.
- All water activities will take place at Top Barn Centre, Hallow.
- Cubs taking part in water activities at Top Barn must be able to swim and be confident in the water.
- There will be a maximum of 120 places.
- Full instruction is given on all activities. Instruction is provided by members of the Activate Team and the activities staff at Rhydd Covert Camp Site.
- Transport to Top Barn will be by coach.
- Cubs can only attend if they have Leaders from their pack coming for the day or firm arrangements are made in advance of the event for them to join with another pack.
- All activities are run under current Scout Association Safety Rules for Adventurous Activities.
